i **Yamanashi Maglev Exhibition Center**

The Linear Chuo Shinkansen will be the **fastest bullet train in the world** with a speed approximately twice that of current shinkansen at **500 km/h**. You can view test runs on the Yamanashi Maglev Test Track, study superconductive maglev and Linear Chuo Shinkansen mechanisms, and learn about the next generation vehicle that is the superconductive maglev train

Boso no Mura ("Boso Village") is an open air museum that aims to expose its visitors to the traditional local lifestyle. There are samurai residences, farm houses, and merchant houses. At the various craft workshops in the village, visitors can participate in traditional papermaking, blacksmithing and the tea ceremony or try on a Japanese armor at your own expenses.
